CORONAVIRUS COURSES ARE NOW AVAILABLE THROUGH HEALTHSTREAM

IHA WIO, in collaboration with its online training partner, HealthStream, is offering a collection of carefully curated courses to all WIO participants. Relevant to COVID-19, these courses are designed to educate staff on current guidelines for infection control across various care settings and precautions for airborne pathogens. The courses also offer best practices for using personal protective equipment (PPE) and maintaining proper hand hygiene.

In addition, Healthstream has created an easy-to-use reference guide of infographics and helpful links from the CDC website. The collection of 21 courses is available today for

assignment or self-enrollment. Simply go to the Healthstream catalog and type in COVID-19 in the search bar. The 21 courses will then populate the page.

IHA WIO CHROMEBOOKS CAN BE USED TO ENHANCE REMOTE WORK ARRANGEMENTS AND CONNECT RESIDENTS TO FAMILY AND FRIENDS

IHA WIO has the capability to enable your Chromebooks with SKYPE, Facebook Messenger and/or other apps to visually connect residents to friends and family while visitors are prohibited in residential buildings. We are also able to configure Chromebooks for staff that may be working remotely and need access to a Citrix or Intranet environment.

Set up related to these enhanced uses can be done remotely. Simply contact your Regional Liaison with a list of the serial numbers for each Chromebook you would like to use.
